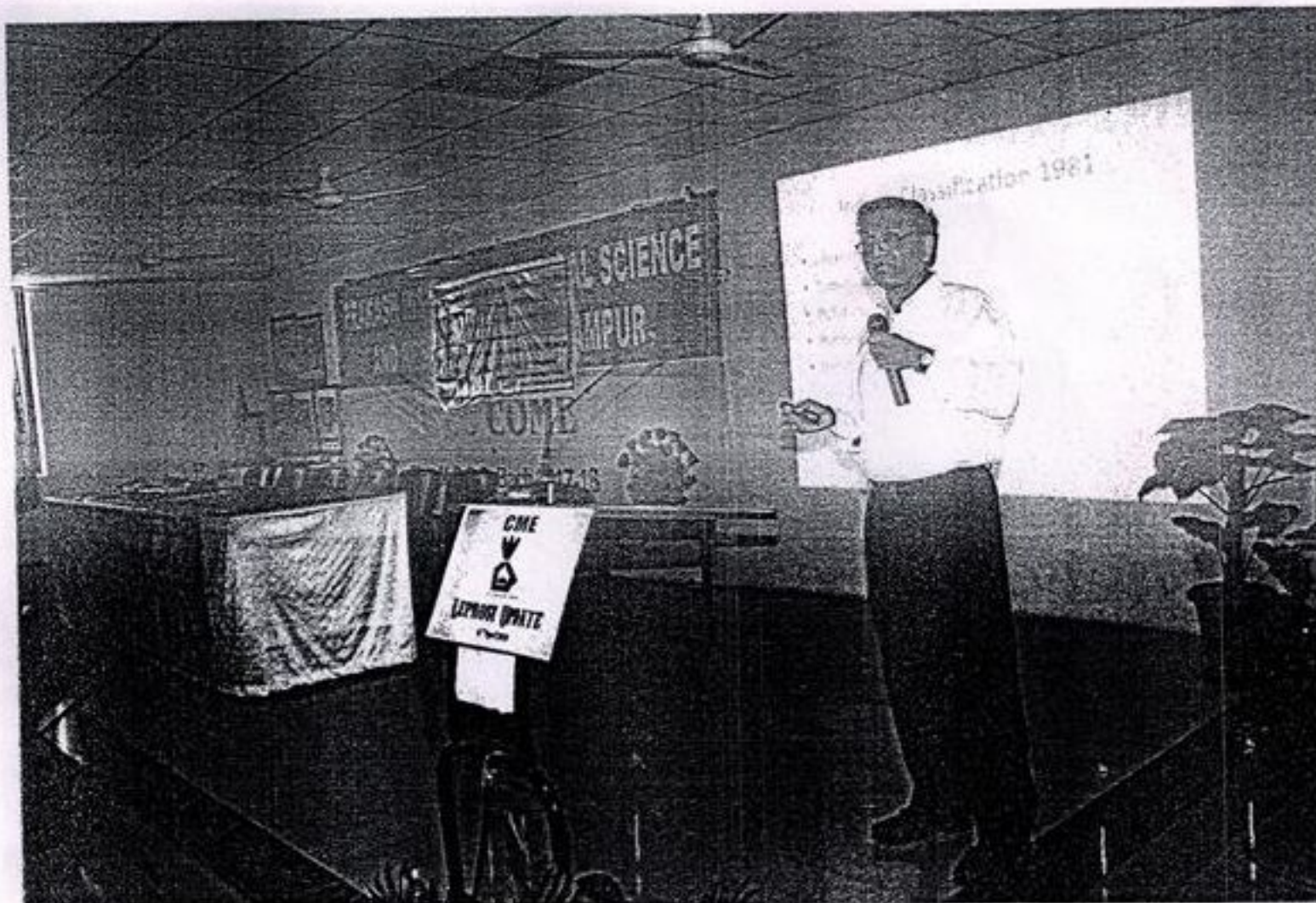


CME on Leprosy Update : 8th April 2018
